

Fieldtrip 7: Port Adelaide: More Than A Football Team

The Tour will provide insights into the rich history of the original port for Adelaide and the Major Port for South Australia.

A cruise on the Port River will introduce participants to the friendly Port River Dolphins and provide a vantage point for seeing different elements of the port. Participants will view the main port facilities and learn about changing trends in the port's operation.

A number of issues have confronted planners in recent years in relation to Port Adelaide – the impact of port activities on the natural environment, transport, urban blight, land reclamation and re-development and the impact of gentrification. These issues will be explored at particular locations.

During the day you will be guided by a range of people each knowledgeable in their particular field. Lunch will take place in the Port Dock Brewery Hotel, located in the heart of the historic precinct.

You will receive a set of specific resources including, statistics, maps and photographs that should provide a useful basis for using Pot Adelaide as a Case Study in your Geography classes.
