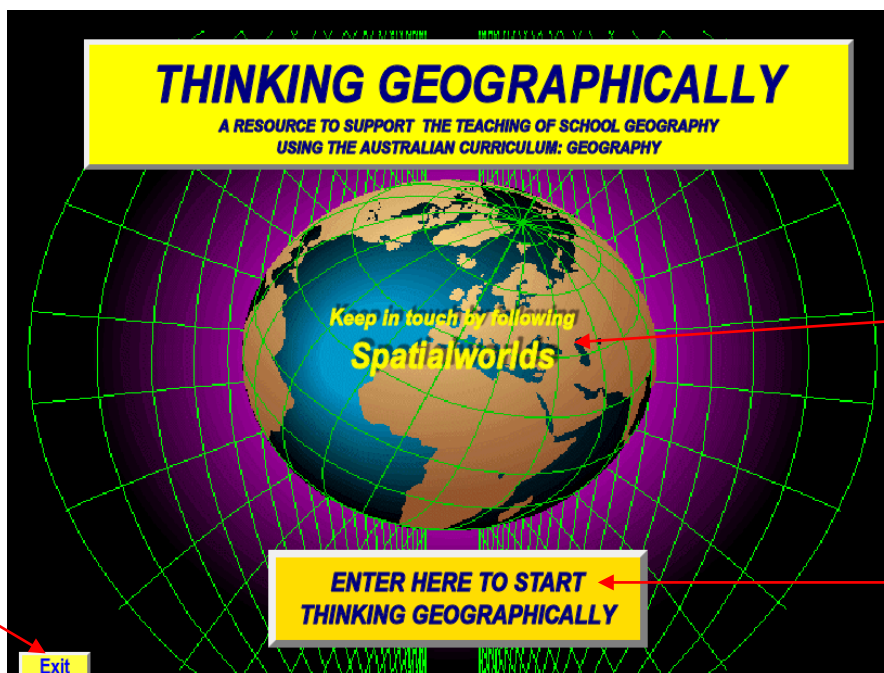


# USING THE 'THINKING GEOGRAPHICALLY' DVD

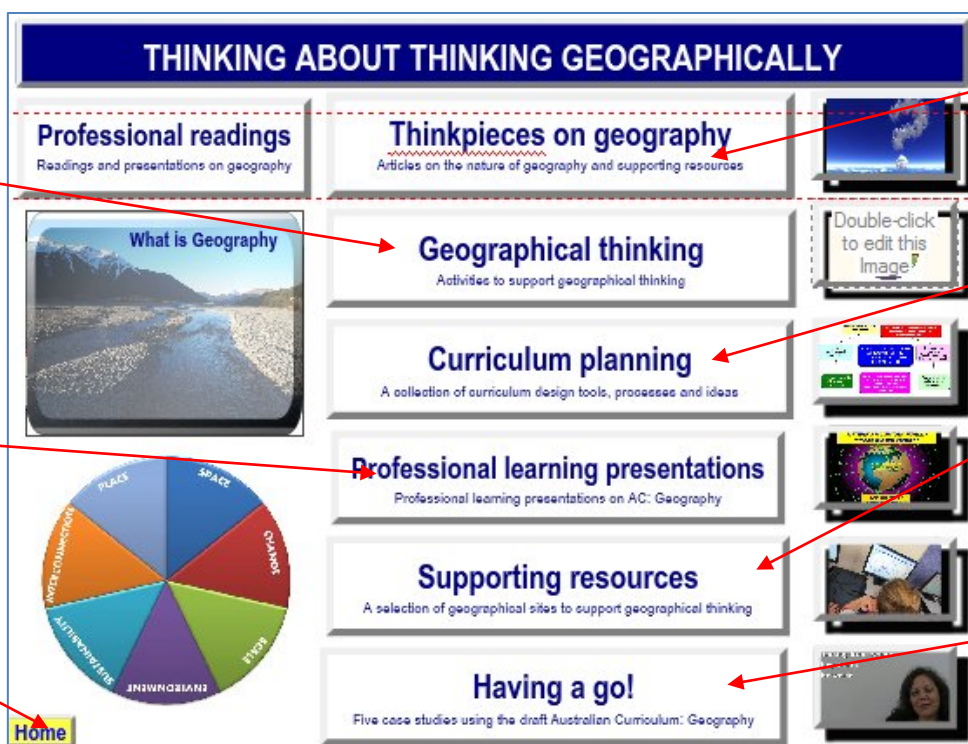
